

Congressman Ben Cline (VA-6)

Nomination Application Packet For the United States Service Academies

Acceptance at an Academy involves at least a nine-year obligation: four years at the Academy and a minimum of five years in the U.S. Military Service.

It is in your best interest to request a nomination through all sources available to you: Presidential, Vice-Presidential, Senatorial, and Congressional. If your parent served eight years in the military, or was killed in action, you may be eligible for a Presidential or Vice-Presidential nomination. Please contact the Service Academies for more information. It is strongly recommended each candidate apply to both U.S. Senators, in addition to Congressman Cline's office.

Eligibility Requirements

As of July 1st of the year of admission, applicants must be:

- ❖ 17 years of age, but not yet 23;
- ❖ A citizen of the United States;
- Unmarried, not pregnant, and have no legal obligation to support a child or dependent; and
- ❖ A legal resident of the Commonwealth of Virginia and the Sixth Congressional District of Virginia.

Nomination Procedures (Nominations will be announced by the end of the calendar year.)

To be considered for a nomination by Congressman Cline, each applicant must submit an Application Packet to the Roanoke District Office on or before 5:00 pm October 24th, 2025. Each packet must contain the following items:

- **Application form** (included in this packet)
- **Extracurricular Activities Worksheet** (included in this packet)
- ❖ 3 Letters of Recommendation: One should be written by your High School Principal or Guidance Counselor. The other letters may be written by teachers, coaches, scout masters, clergy or community leaders who can accurately comment on applicant's character, abilities and potential for success at an Academy. Letters should be sealed and submitted with the application packet.
- ❖ SAT/ACT Scores: Scores may be submitted with the candidate's official high school transcript.

 You are encouraged to take the SAT or ACT exams "early and often" in order to improve your academic competitiveness. Academies will accept the highest scores in each academic area, regardless of testing date.
- ❖ Official High School Transcript: Include a copy of your senior class schedule.

 Senior grades may be submitted as soon as they are available. Counselors may fax or email them and only the senior grades may be forwarded after the October 24th deadline.
- **Photograph:** Unless specifically requested, photographs will not be returned to the candidate.

<u>Interviews</u> (Interviews will be scheduled between early November – mid December)

Applicants who complete a nomination file will be reviewed by Congressman Cline. If interviews are conducted, applicants are encouraged to dress appropriately for a military academy interview. It is recommended that men wear dress slacks, shirt, and a tie. A coat is optional. It is recommended women wear dress pants, or skirt and dress shirt, or a dress. Tee shirts and jeans are not recommended.

SERVICE ACADEMY NOMINATION APPLICATION

Applicants must directly contact the Academies to open an admissions file. The Academy will return to you their Candidate Kit or Application Packet with specific instructions for their admissions process.

The Congressional nomination materials ARE SEPARATE FROM the materials you must provide to the Academies. It is to your advantage to apply to more than one Academy.
